**Reverend Barbara writes:** When I was away visiting my sister a few days ago, we visited an old haunt near where I lived as a child. We went for a walk round a very old garden which still boasted snowdrops, in flower and daffodils on their way and peonies were in bud for later on.

Then we went round a corner and there were the most striking golden crocuses nestling in the grass and close by, and in contrast, were a host of purple ones. I have not seen many of these around this year and these were very special to me. It was beauty not only in number and in surprise, but it was also a lesson in how remarkable contrast and difference can be. This is now the beginning of Lent, a time when Christians can fast, eat less, give more to charity, read a longer passage from the Bible, or perhaps go to a Lent course to share ideas and prayer with others. There is a morning and an evening group running in Ash this year and you might like to try coming to one.

Today in our world, life is difficult and change is happening at even greater speed. It is like a new industrial revolution, where even the weather has become more unpredictable and scary.
