CHILLENDEN HALL 100 CLUB: RULES

- 1. The object of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the operational running costs and routine maintenance of the fabric and structure of Chillenden Church Hall.
- 2. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of the Rainbow Appeal Committee (registered Charity no. 1113056) of All Saints Chillenden PCC who will also administer the Club.
- 3. The 100 Club will be run as a Small Society Lottery and will be registered with Dover District Council.
- 4. The 100 Club is open to all Residents of the Parish of Chillenden with Knowlton and the surrounding area, their family and friends.
- 5. Members must be 16 or over.
- 6. Members must fill in an Application Form.
- 7. Entry to monthly draws will be by subscription of £5 per month per number, paid in advance, preferably by Standing Order based on a minimum period of twelve months (£60 per number per annum).
- 8. Members may have more than one number. The 100 Club shall not be limited to 100 members.
- 9. Subsequent to the first draw (to be announced separately) additional new members will be entered for the draw in the calendar month that follows receipt of the first monthly payment. Responsibility for ensuring that the subscription has been paid rests with the individual member, not the Rainbow Appeal Committee.
- 10. The draw will be held monthly, with winning numbers generated randomly. The draw will generally be held at The Griffins Head Chillenden on the first Friday of each month.
- 11. Winners will be contacted personally by 100 Club administrators who will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a week of each monthly draw.
- 12. Names of winners will be posted on the Village Noticeboard and on the Chillenden Village website (chillenden.org.uk) each month after the draw.
- 13. The regular monthly prize fund will be 50% of the total income for that month, with the remaining 50% of the total income allocated to the Rainbow Appeal Committee to fund operational running costs and routine maintenance of the fabric and structure of Chillenden Church Hall. Any surplus will go into a capital fund.
- 14. There will be two prizes each month:-
 - 1st prize = 80% of monthly prize fund
 - 2nd prize = 20% of monthly prize fund
- 15. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
- 16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 17. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Rainbow Appeal Committee funds after 6 months.
- 18. The decision of the Rainbow Appeal Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
- 19. The Rainbow Appeal Committee shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
